### 1945-P Jefferson Nickel - Graded MS66 by NGC

A frosty untoned superb-gem struck on the silver-manganese alloy used from 1942-1945 to conserve nickel for use by the armed forces in World War II. No distracting marks or blemishes, even when inspected under magnification. A choice example of the 'War Nickel' type that would fit nicely into anyone's collection. ## 1949 Roosevelt Dime - Graded MS66+ by PCGS

A beautifully original coin with concentric royal blue and deep red color typically witnessed on pieces stored in older coin albums.

Well struck for the date (though just missing the fully split bands on the torch on the reverse for the "FB" specification at PCGS).

Exceptional both in terms of eye-appeal and technical merits for the MS66 grade, this example earned the coveted "+" designation reserved for high-end specimens.
