1929-S Walking Liberty Half Dollar - VF

A solidly VF example of this tough-to-find date with a lovely medium grey patina.

A choice original early date "Walker."

PCGS Price Guide: \$50

Minimum bid: \$35

If you see striated lines on either and or both faces of an unplated Lincoln cent, it is more than likely a manipulated coin.

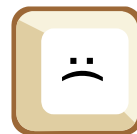
One odd fact is that the Lincoln copper/zinc planchet is plated *after* the planchet has been through the upset mill.

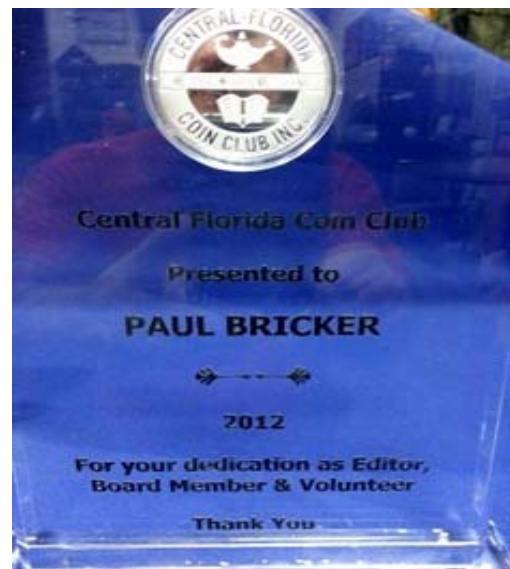
For those of you that didn't know him personally, Paul Bricker was one of the most active members of the Central Florida Coin Club.

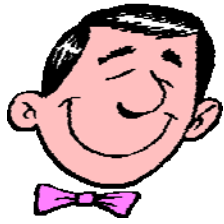
Paul would attend every function of the Central Florida Coin Club, from picnics to shows to whatever was planned-you could count on seeing Paul there!

We were fortunate enough to be able to present Paul with a small token of appreciation at the CFCC Holiday Celebration in December.

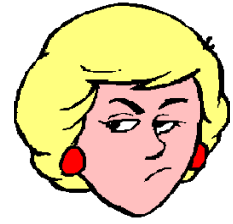
